## **APPLICATIONS**

Once activated, the films provide bonds with high initial values, and which have good heat resistance. The adhesion to PVC, rubber and polyurethane materials, as well as to a variety of fabrics, is excellent.


## MATERIAL PREPARATION

**Pearlbond™ 1160L** does not need to be dried. Only is advisable after long exposition to highly moisture environments.

Recommended drying conditions is 3-6 hours at 40°C in a hot air circulatory, vacuum or desiccant-air dryer, avoiding high pressures.

## **EXTRUSION**

The suggested processing-temperature profiles for film extrusion (flat film) are depicted in the figure below:
